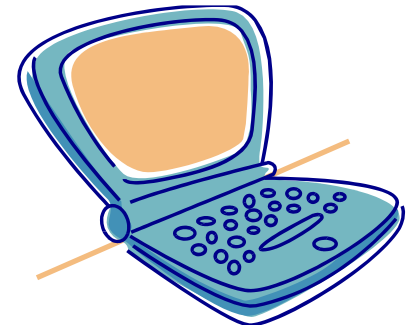




E-Safety
