How we used our Pupil Premium Grant report 2015

In the year 2014-2015 we spent our pupil premium which was approximately £19000 in the following ways;

A continuation of the effective support and intervention strategies including targeted individual reading enrichment, booster groups, nurture groups and overlearning support.

A contribution to the cost of a Family and Community Mentor to support children and families in school with specific interventions planned for targeted children and groups of children.

A contribution to the fees to allow children to access after school clubs.

The impact of these strategies enabled;

100% of children entitled to pupil premium grant to achieve the national standard or higher in reading, writing and maths at the end of Key stage 1.

For the year 2015-2016 we expect to receive approximately £27000 in Pupil premium grant. We aim to continue the effective strategies listed above and also set up a parent fund of £100 per child to ensure that children are able to access extra curricular activities such as sports and French. This fund can be accessed by parents or carers through the school office and any requests will be treated in the strictest confidence. If you require more information please speak with Mrs Morrison.
