Reception & Nursery Parent Consultations - Autumn Term

As you know we changed the format of the parent's consultations this autumn. Instead of the usual 1:1 session for 10 minutes only without children, we gave families an opportunity to attend with their child and work in the classroom. You were all allocated an hour within which to attend, and you could have stayed for any part or indeed all of that hour with your child.

The idea behind this change was to allow you to see the classroom where your child spends a large part of their day and work alongside them at a number of different activities. This enabled both parents to attend without the need for childcare. The teachers were all present and were available for a chat about how your child has settled and how they are getting on. Some parents who needed more time in a quieter environment, without their child, were given that extra 1:1 time at a later date. Many children were proud to show off their classroom to parents and enjoyed completing activities with them. This also enabled parents to see what the expectations are of the children in school and how they are often expected to work independently.

In order to review how you as parents felt about the changes we would appreciate it if you could complete the following slip and return it to school. This helps us to plan for the future and ensure we are meeting the needs of all.
