Forest School sessions will be starting again after the half-term holiday with Willow Class on Tuesday 14th June, followed on Tuesday 28th June.

Elm Class will go on the following Tuesday 21st June, followed on the 5th July. These are our final sessions for the year, so we would like to make a campfire and need as much help as possible, please?

Please dress your child in old trousers or leggings (shorts don't protect their legs so wellies can rub!) on those dates and socks that will fit in their wellies! We have waterproof jackets and trousers for every child and their wellies need to be in school. Your child will hopefully not need an extra jumper under the waterproof jackets, but will need a sunhat! Please apply sun-cream before school that will last. We will still wear waterproofs as a protection from undergrowth, the sun and ticks. If it is very sunny the jackets will still be available whilst in Palmers Rough, and then carried back to school. Please ensure that everything is labelled with your child's name. The children will change into their full school uniform on their return, please send this in a separate bag making sure they have their school shoes with them!

We have put up a list for helpers, on each classroom door as we will need your valuable assistance with a Forest School session.
