At the end of the course you will receive a certificate of attendance from Solihull College. Best of all, this fabulous opportunity is completely **FREE** and we will offer a **FREE crèche** (on the school site) for people with pre-school children.

The course will cover topics such as:

- Developing speaking and listening skills.
- Learning styles and how these can vary from child to child.
- The phonics approach to teaching reading and writing.
- Rhythm and rhyme – why sharing action songs and nursery rhymes helps children learn.
- Games to develop literacy and numeracy skills.
- Sharing books and listening to children read.
- Developing counting and problem solving skills.
- Encouraging writing
